#### ABOUT THE BOOK

For twelve long years, the dread fortress of Azkaban had held an infamous prisoner named Sirius Black. Convicted of killing thirteen people with a single curse, he was said to be the apparent heir to the Dark Lord, Voldemort. Now he has escaped, leaving only two clues as to where he might be headed: Harry Potter's defeat of You-Know-Who was Black's downfall as well. And the Azkaban guards heard Black muttering in his sleep, "He's at Hogwarts... he's at Hogwarts." Harry Potter isn't safe, not even within the walls of his magical school, surrounded by his friends. Because on top of it all, there may well be a traitor in their midst.

#### **NEW CHARACTERS**

#### Sirius Black

Most infamous prisoner to ever be held at Azkaban, the wizard's prison. He was accused of murdering 13 people with a single curse. Sirius Black was a Hogwarts student many years ago and best friend of James Potter, Harry's father. He is Harry's godfather and an animagus. What does SIRIUS mean?

#### Remus J. Lupin

Teacher of Defense Against the Dark Arts in Harry's third year at Hogwarts. Professor Lupin can change into a werewolf. His nickname is MOONY.

Why do you think is that his nickname?

#### Peter Pettigrew

An animagus wizard who attended Hogwarts with Harry's father. For years he has taken the form of Scabbers, Ron Weasley's old and tired pet rat.

What do you associate with the nickname WORMTAIL?

#### **DISCUSSION TOPICS**

-Read the following quotations from the Harry Potter books and discuss the truth that each reveals.

"You can exist without your soul, you know, as long as your brain and heart are still working. But you'll have no sense of self anymore, no memory, no ... anything. There's no chance at all of recovery. You'll just-exist. As an empty shell." (The Prisoner of Azkaban, page 247)

"You think the dead we loved ever truly leave us? You think that we don't recall them more clearly than ever in times of great trouble?....You know, Harry, in a way, you did see your father last night....You found him inside yourself." (The Prisoner of Azkaban, page 427-428)

-In each of the Harry Potter books, Harry seems to end up in deep trouble. Why do you think this happens?

-Harry, Hermione and Ron are able to get up to all sorts of mischief when they are using Harry's Invisibility Cloak. Imagine that you are in possession of an Invisibility Cloak for one day. Write a story about your adventures..
